No last names or other details will be included - God knows the people for whom we pray and what they need. People for whom prayers are requested MUST have given their permission for that inclusion. Prayer requests to this team will NOT be also treated as requests for pastoral visits - none of the information required for such visits will be included in the request since each will consist only of a person's first name. Names will be maintained on the list for two weeks. If you have any questions please let me know. I look forward to working with you.

DIOCESAN CONFIRMATION

The Diocesan Confirmation Service will be held within our building on April 14, 2018 at 2:00 P.M. At this service, Bishop Waynick our Bishop Provisional will be confirming and receiving individuals within the Episcopal Church.

Confirmation: is an adult affirmation or agreement with your baptismal vows that may have been made for you by your parents. The rite is normally preceded with a time of education and reflection with clergy and others. Those who wish to be confirmed should be in the 8th grade or older.

Through reception a person who has been confirmed in another denomination seeks to be received as an Episcopalian.

St. Christopher's has been asked to host this event for all of the churches in the southern part of our Diocese. We will provide ushers, greeters, lectors, Eucharistic ministers and a reception following the service. We need your help. We want our sister and brother Episcopalians from all over our Diocese to know that we stand with them and they are welcome here.
