NEW KEYS MADE FOR ALL DOORS

The Entry Doors and
The Office Doors
Re-Keyed

If you currently hold an entry door key or master key, you must get a new key. The new "A" keys are digitally cut so that they can only be duplicated by

a locksmith with the digital computer code. copies cannot be made at local hardware store. These keys are expensive, between 20.00-25.00 each. Only two doors will be accessible from the outside with the new key, the front door and the first west door between the youth room and choir room. Persons assigned keys will need to sign a form indicating their understanding that if the key is lost or at the conclusion of their term of office, they must return the key.
